## Induction: First 48 Hours

#### Orientation

- Estates to include tour of the venue and any other relevant areas (refer to regional induction)
- Defib/ Anaphylaxis/ BLS equipment
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Welcome pack (local version)
- Documentation/reporting systems

#### Safety

- · Occupational health
- Protocols for blood exposure/needle stick injury

#### Training pathway

- · Training requirements for each person/staff group
- COVID-19 Core Vaccine recap (PHE Core Training slide set)

#### Competency assessment and sign off

- IM injection demonstration and supervised practice, due to vaccine preparation and unusual characteristics
- · Clinical assessment and consent
  - Mental capacity
- Supervision arrangements

#### Considerations of Specific patient groups, for example:

- People who are planning a pregnancy, pregnant or breast feeding
- People with bleeding disorders

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## Health and Well-being for Staff

- Access to information about how to improve own and others mental health, wellbeing, and healthier lifestyle choices
- Access to interventions that help to improve mental health, musculoskeletal health and well-being
